2. Sewer will be \$30.00 for the first six months January-June with a three-dollar late fee by the 30<sup>th</sup> of the month all residents are subject to the fee. The remaining six months will be looked at in May 2021.
3. Budget \$1.00 per hour all employees.
4. Budget \$1.00 per hour per Police and Patrolman.
5. Maintenance and repair of roads \$300,000.00
6. Building Capitol Improvement \$10,000.00 new carpeting and lighting.
7. Police Capitol Purchases \$44,560.00
8. Public works Capitol Purchases Dump Truck \$82,500.00
9. Capitol Improvements Internet Services \$200,000.00
10. Supervisors budget Loss \$38,362.00
11. Municipal Authority Surplus \$40,800.00
