## RESOLUTION NO. 2016-\_\_

### A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FOSTER, COUNTY OF SCHUYLKILL, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE FEE STRUCTURE FOR SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT WORK AND SEWAGE PERMITS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF FOSTER.

The Supervisors of THE TOWNSHIP OF FOSTER, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolve that the following fees for service indicated are hereby established and are to remain in full force and effect until such time as the Township, by subsequent resolution, may adopt a new or additional schedule of fees and costs.

- 1. Site Testing**

Site Investigation & Soil Probe Analysis (Includes 2 probes per existing or proposed lot)	\$320.00
Additional Probes	\$80.00/Probe
Percolation (Perc) Testing (Assumes 2 tests of six (6) holes each @ same time)	\$560.00
Additional Perc Tests (per set of six (6) holes)	\$320.00/Perc

Additional Interim Inspection	\$80.00
Call back for final inspection (if Final Inspection not approved)	\$160.00

(Gravity Fed In-Ground Systems)

Hourly Rate for every additional hour past first five (5) hours	\$80.00/hr
  
- 4. Single Family Residences Requiring Pressure Dosing**  
(Conventional and Alternate Pressure Dosed Beds and Trenches, and Alternate Components)

Design Review, Permit Issuance, (2) Interim Inspections and (1) Final Inspection	\$560.00 (Base)
Hourly rate for every additional hour past first seven (7) hours	\$80.00/hr
  
- 5. Single Family Residences**  
(Drip Irrigation, IRSIS, A/B Soil, CO-OPRFSIII)

Design Review, Permit Issuance, (3) Interim Inspections and (1) Final Inspection	\$720.00 (Base)
Hourly rate for every additional hour past first nine (9) hours	\$80.00/hr
  
- 6. Single Family Residences – Holding Tank**  
(Design Review, Permit Issuance, and Final Inspection) \$360.00
  
- 7. Planning Module Review** \$80.00/hr
  
- 8. Permit Transfer** \$160.00
  
- 9. Complaints and Malfunctioning System Investigation** \$80.00/hr
  
- 10. Court Hearing Attendance** \$110.00/hr
  
- 11. System Component Repair Permits**  
(Does not include repair or replacement of absorption area) \$80.00/hr

12. All Commercial, Business, Multi-Family Units and Subdivisions shall be billed a fee of \$80.00/hr.
13. All work not covered in the above will be billed at a fee of \$80.00/hr.
14. Application for any system must include a completed PADEP application. A minimum check of \$200.00 application fee is in addition to other fees and must accompany all initial applications. Payment of fees shall be made by Certified Check, Money Order or equal; to the Sewage Enforcement Officer payable to THE TOWNSHIP OF FOSTER.
15. Please note that the above fees do not include the digging of the 7' soil probe pit, the individual percolation test holes or initial pre-soak (8 to 24 hours prior to testing). The percolation test site must be accessible by two-wheel drive vehicle to within fifty feet. The applicant must provide a back-hoe and operator for digging of the probe pit and must also dig the percolation test holes. The applicant must provide a minimum of 50 gallons of water at each percolation test site.
16. Mileage: Mileage may be charged at a rate permitted by PADEP. Mileage costs for non-planning work items (i.e. permit, inspections, malfunctions, complaints, etc) are eligible for reimbursement from DEP.
17. Fees must be paid in full prior to release of permits/test results.
