2. ATV'S – We Are expecting more off-road Riders within Township due to the warm weather.

3. Noise Ordinance 02-2021 Receiving Questions and Complaints concerning various disturbances on weekend starting at 7:00 A.M. Sunday and legal Holidays are covered within the ordinance but Saturday is not. But from 7A.M. Saturday, until 9:00 P.M. seems to be the area in question.

4. E bikes: Complaints concerning young people riding E-bikes around the walking path and in the parking areas. Electric Bikes can accelerate up to 40 MPH.

5. Fireworks -4th of July is coming and so are the fireworks. Purchase only legal fireworks.

Class C- Consumer Fireworks are legal: Firecrackers, Roman Candles, sparklers ETC. Must be at least 18 and must have permission on various properties and be 150- feet from any building.

Display Fireworks: Those set off by an organization with a permit.

Federally illegal explosives: M-80 M 100, Blockbuster, Cherry Bomb, quarter or half stick explosive devices, violation of us, is a felony of the 3rd degree.

Foster Township Noise Ordinance also regulates the fireworks.

CELL PHONE LAW:

JUNE 6TH-DRIVERS CAUGHT USING OR TOUCHING THEIR CELL PHONES WHILE DRIVING OR STOPPED ON THE ROADWAY, WILL FACE A \$50 FINE. DISTRACTED DRIVING. PA VC 3316.1

NOISE ORDINANCE 02-2021

RECEIVING QUESTIONS AND COMPLAINTS CONCERNING VARIOUS DISTURBANCES ON WEEK-ENDS STARTING AT 7:00 am. SUNDAY AND LEGAL HOLIDAYS ARE COVERED WITHING THE ORDINANCE BUT SATURDAY IS NOT. YOU CAN NOT CAUSE NOISE FROM 9:00 pm FRIDAY TILL 7:00 AM SATURDAY, BUT FROM 7:00 AM UNTIL 9:00 PM, SEEMS TO BE THE AREA IN QUESTION.

E-BIKES: COMPLAINTS CONCERNING YOUNG PEOPLE RIDING E-BIKES AROUND THE WALKING PATH AND IN THE PARKING AREAS. ELECTRIC BIKES CAN EXCELLERATE UP TO 40 MPH.

FIREWORKS – 4TH OF JULY IS COMING AND SO ARE THE FIREWORKS. PURCHASE ONLY LEGAL FIREWORKS.

CLASS C – CONLSUMER FIREWORKS ARE LEGAL: FIRECRACKERS, ROMAN CANDLES, BOTTLE ROCKETS, SPARKLES ETC. MUST BE AT LEAST 18 AND MUST HAVE PERMISSION ON VARIOUS PROPERTY AND BE 150 FEET FROM ANY BUILDING.

DISPLAY FIREWORKS: THOSE SET OFF BY AN ORGANIZATION WITH A PERMIT

FEDERALLY ILLEGAL EXPLOSIVES: M-8, M-100, BLOCKBUSTER, CHERRY BOMB, QUARTER OR HALF-STICK EXPLOVISE DEVICES ARE NOT FIREWORKS, BUT EXPLOSIVIE DEVICES. VIOLATION OF USE/POSSESSION IS A FELONY OF 3RD DEGREE.
